XBRL AND BENEFITS



What?

- eXtensible Business Reporting Language (XBRL) is an open international standard for digital business reporting.
- It is in the family of "XML languages" a digital-type language that communicates business and financial information.
- XBRL allows for the contents of Financial Statements (FS), Annual Return (AR), Exemption Application (EA) and Key Financial Indicator (KFI) to be represented by clearly defined taxonomies.

Benefits?

- Reduces time and cost of gathering financial and non-financial information.
- Captures financial information in various formats into a common digital language.
- Enhances corporate compliance processes and improves data analysis and quality of information.
 - Enhances data integrity and reliability.

INTRODUCTION TO MBRS



Malaysian Business Reporting System (MBRS) is a submission platform based on the extensible Business Reporting Language (XBRL) format.



The MBRS allows companies for the submission of:

- Annual Return (AR);
- Financial Statements and Reports (FS); and
- Exemption Applications (EA) related to the FS and AR applications.

The guiding principles behind the financial and non-financial scopes under MBRS 2.0 are based on:

- 1)Companies Act 2016;
- 2)Companies Act 1965;
- 3)Applicable approved accounting standards for financial statements of:
 - •Public companies and its subsidiaries, associate of, or jointly controlled by, an entity which is required to prepare or lodge any financial statement under any law administered by the Securities Commission or the Bank Negara Malaysia using the Malaysian Financial Reporting Standards (MFRS); and
 - •Private companies using the Malaysian Private Entities Reporting Standards in Malaysia (MPERS).

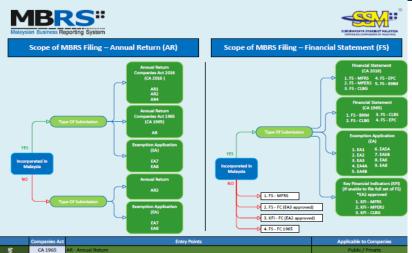

This include basic validations rules for each submission.

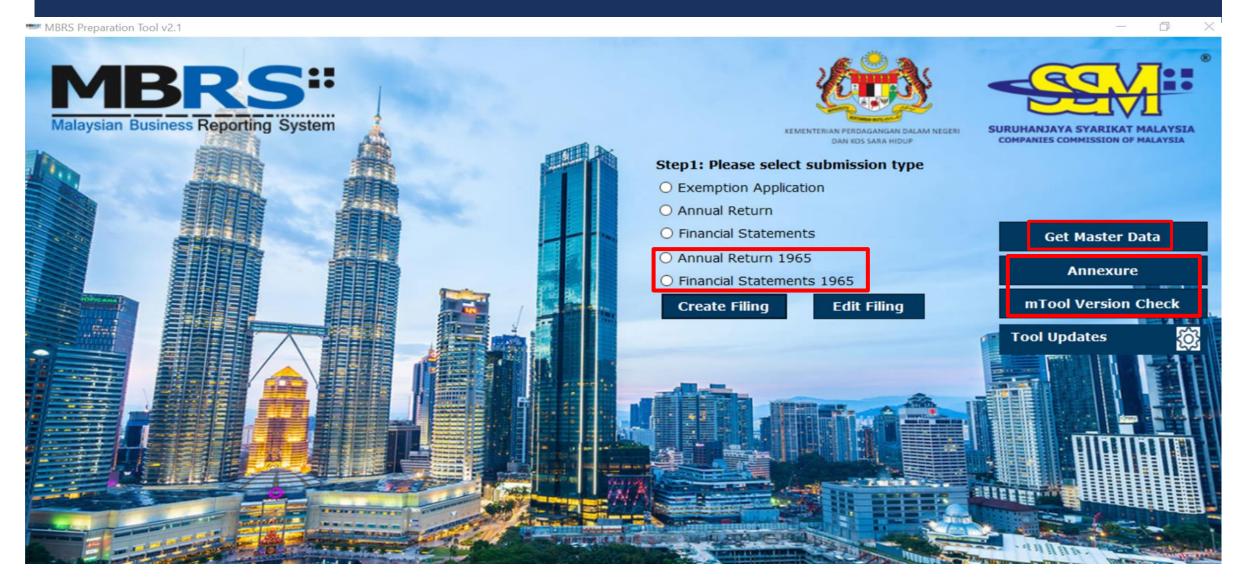
MBRS Preparation Tool (mTool)

A preparation tool that allow companies to prepare and generate AR, FS and EA in XBRL format.

MBRS Portal (mPortal)

A submission platform to lodge AR, FS and EA to SSM.

Types of Rectification Application:

Standard Rectification;

- Section 602 CA 2016
- To rectify certain data in AR or FS that previously submitted either in MBRS or OTC

Filing Information Rectification;

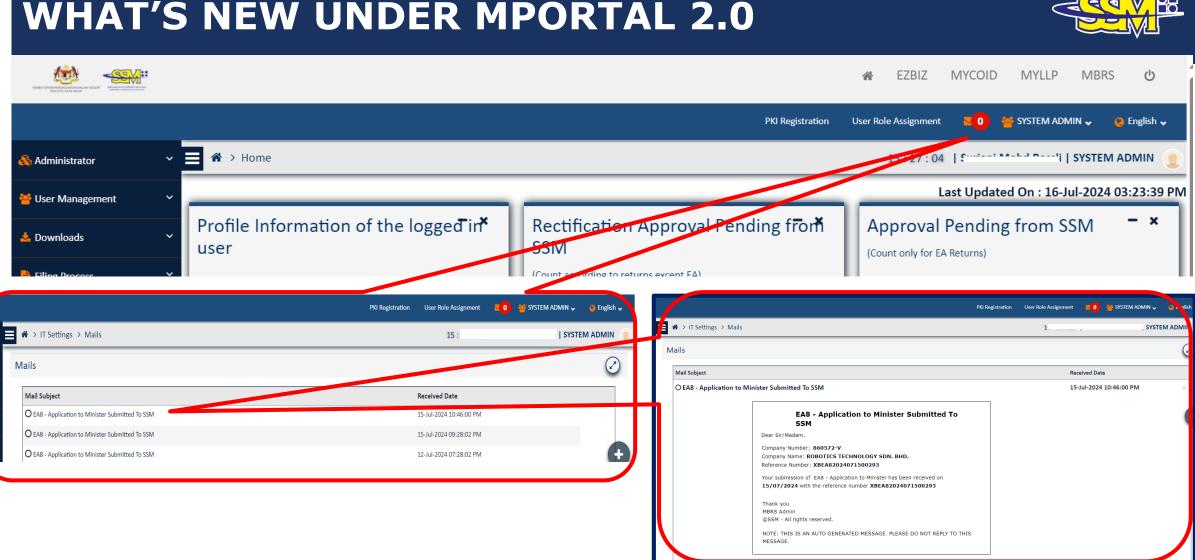
- Section 602 CA 2016
- To rectify especially on Filing Information.
 - ➤ FYE in FS that previously submitted as 30/12/23 instead 31/12/23 either in MBRS or OTC
 - ➤ Type of submission from AR4 to AR1

Nil Filing

- To rectify but not require to lodge / upload any new AR or FS.
 - Double Submission or Court Order without Replacement

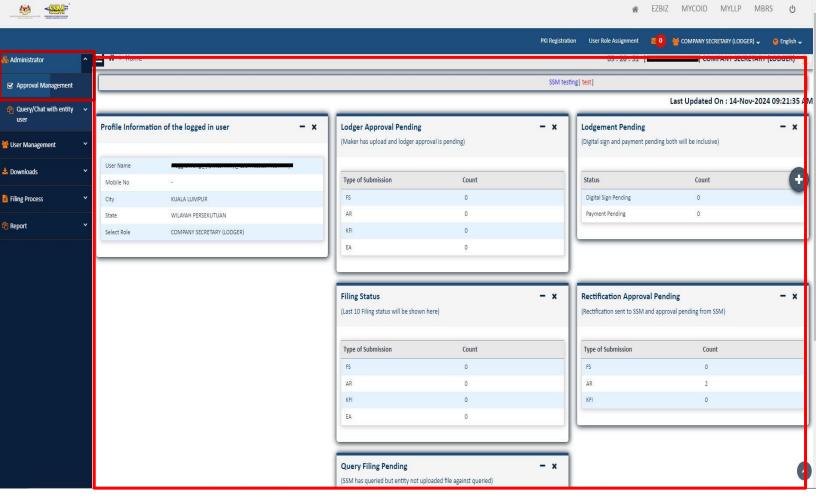

Dashboard for External User

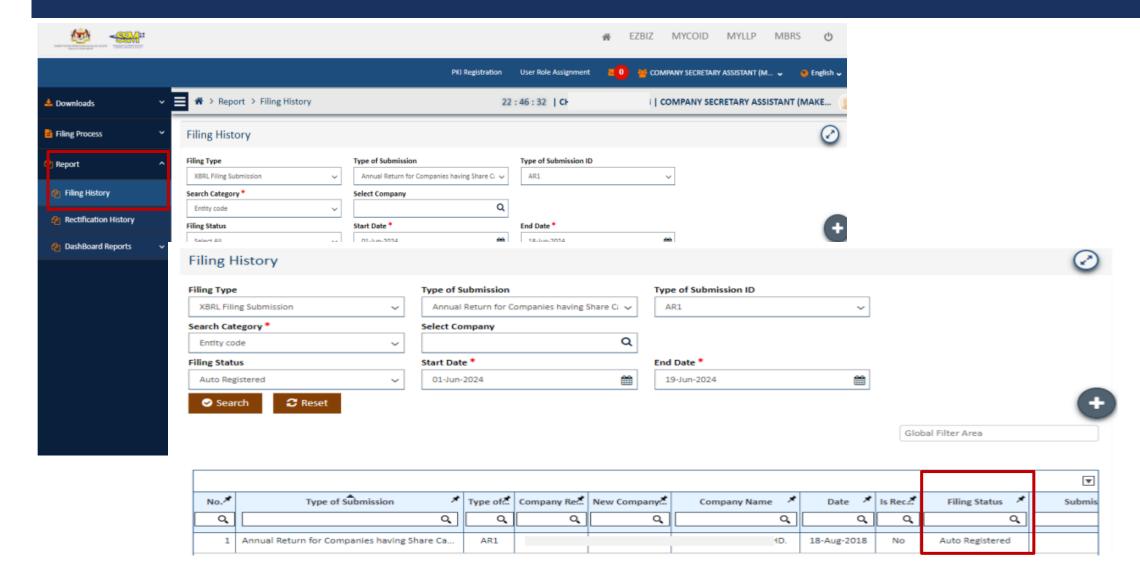

- Lodger Approval Pending- This section will show the count of fillings which are uploaded by maker and Lodger approval is pending (view only)

- * Pre-populate Annual Return data by using Old Company Number format
- * Edit filing using zip file generated in mTool 1.0 to generate new zip file using mTool 2.1
- * Lodger requires to update Practicing Certificate (PC) for first time log in mPortal 2.0. Kindly ensure PC has been registered through e-Secretary
- * Click "Typed Domain" to add or delete row
- * Use Mozilla Firefox browser for efficient payment experience
- * New Company Number is mandatory to be used in MBRS 2.0
- * Clear cache if browser is stagnate

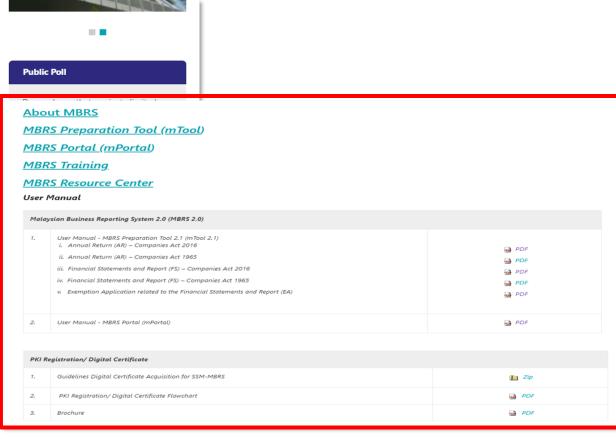
