





### COURSE INTRODUCTION

The Limited Liability Partnerships (Amendment) Act 2024 [Act A1728] was gazetted on 17 October 2024. The first phase which relate to advertising on the SSM website and provisions relating to beneficial owners are expected to be implemented in the first quarter of 2025. While the second phase related to the corporate rescue scheme (judicial management and corporate voluntary arrangements) is expected to come into effect in the fourth quarter of 2025.

The purpose of the Phased Enforcement of the Act is to ensure that all parties can adapt to the changes introduced and give time for the development and improvement of the relevant system.
