A 30-Days Moratorium after the end of the Movement Control Order (MCO/Total Lockdown for lodgment of statutory documents under the Companies Act 2016 (CA 2016) and the Limited Liability Partnerships Act 2012 (LLP Act 2012) for: (a) All statutory documents required to be lodged to the Registrar under the CA 2016 and LLP Act 2012 during the MCO/ Total Lockdown period; and (b) the late lodgement fee is waived.
