MORATORIUM 30 DAYS FOR LODGEMENT OF STATUTORY DOCUMENTS UNDER THE COMPANIES ACT 2016 AND THE LIMITED LIABILITY PARTNERSHIP ACT 2012

NO.	QUESTION	ANSWER
1.	What is meant by this moratorium?	<p>A 30-Days Moratorium after the end of the Movement Control Order (MCO/Total Lockdown for lodgment of statutory documents under the Companies Act 2016 (CA 2016) and the Limited Liability Partnerships Act 2012 (LLP Act 2012) for :</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">(a) All statutory documents required to be lodged to the Registrar under the CA 2016 and LLP Act 2012 during the MCO/ Total Lockdown period; and(b) the late lodgement fee is waived.
2.	When is the implementation date of this moratorium?	The implementation date of this moratorium will commence on 1December 2021 until 31 December 2021.

NO.	QUESTION	ANSWER
3	What are the statutory documents involved in this moratorium?	<p>The statutory documents involved are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (a) Statutory documents under the CA 2016; and (b) Statutory documents under the LLPA 2012.
4.	What are the channels for lodgment of the statutory documents?	<p>The statutory documents can be submitted at/through:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (a) Service Counters (via appointment for SSM Offices that are in Phase 3 of the PPN); (b) Dropbox (without appointment); (c) MBRS; and (d) MyCoID2016 System.
5.	Whether late submission fee will be charged if the statutory document is lodged after 31 December 2021 i.e. on or after 1 January 2022?	<p>Yes, effective 1 January 2022 onwards, customers who are late in the lodgment of statutory documents under the CA 2016 and LLPA 2012 will be charged late lodgment fees.</p>
