'INFO FOR SALE'

MCMC probing Lowyat.net report on data breach

KUALA LUMPUR: The notherities are looking into a report that databases with personal data of millions of Mulaysians are being put up for sale.

The report was removed the sources of breach still unknown, was published yesterday on the Lowyat.net forum.

The report was removed two hours later at Mulaysian Communication of Mulaysian Communication of Mulaysian Communications (MCCMC) request.

The commission said it was working with police to investigate the claim.
